There will also be the opportunity for participants to take part in a workshop prior to the competition, run by our Festival Representatives, at no extra cost.

Someone should be present on the Sunday evening to collect any trophies and Certificates of Merit that may be awarded.

The School will be responsible for any awards won.

The teacher or parent must:-

Supply names of entrants and copies of the pieces by 15th December for use by the adjudicator. **Encourage children to perform different pieces.** Once all entries are in, we will let you know if anyone has submitted the same piece and give you the opportunity to change.

Entrants must:

Be under 19 years of age on 11th February 2018.

Keep to the time limit: 2-4 minutes including introduction & setting.

Arrive at the theatre by mid-day on the day of the performance.

Abide by the adjudicator's decision which is final.

Singing:

There is no piano, a guitar or backing track is permitted.

Drama & Drama Duologues:

Costume is not allowed other than as a suggestion.

A maximum of 2 hand props per person may be used.

No set is allowed other than 2 chairs and a small table provided.

Poetry:

One poem of your own choice and one from the list provided.

Movement should be minimal.

One chair is permitted.

All individual work should be appropriate for a family audience.

N.B. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry into the Festival.

Tickets for family and friends booked and paid for prior to the end of January £5 each Tickets booked after 31st January £8 each.
